

DAY 2	<p><b>The Blue Hole</b> Encounter with huge stalactites formed thousands of years ago. Measuring about 1,000 feet in diameter and more than 400 feet deep, you can dive among the stalactites at a depth of 110 to 130 feet. This is a very memorable dive</p>	Up to 5
DAY 3	<p><b>Half Moon Cays Wall</b> Hawksbill turtles and Spotted Eagle Rays are regular sights and there are some of the most spectacular sponge formations found anywhere.</p>	Up to 5
DAY 4	<p><b>The Elbow</b> Located on Turneffe Islands Atoll is one of Belize's most exciting and fish filled dive experiences. Enormous schools of jacks are often sighted in the blue water.</p>	Up to 5
DAY 5	<p>Along the shallow side of a mid-reef at southern Turneffe is The Sayonara, a broken up shipwreck of a small island freighter. The Sayonara is an excellent site for seeing a variety of marine life, including the rare Lined Toadfish found only in Belize.</p>	Up to 5
DAY 6	<p><b>Aquarium</b> Very large Black Groupers, Green Morays, Caribbean Octopus and Midnight Parrotfish are among the reef's inhabitants.</p>	Up to 5
DAY 7	<p>Visibility in excess of 120' can be expected and annual water temperatures range from 78 to 84i F. A wide variety of marine life can be observed during the dives, such as eagle rays, manta rays, turtles, tarpon and the occasional wild dolphin.</p>	2
DAY 8	<p>Check Out on the morning, disembark around 07:00 – 08:00</p>

## FAQ

### PASSPORTS & DOCUMENTATION

Visitors must have a current passport. It is the travelers' responsibility to ensure they have the proper documentation to travel to the destination and return to their country. Please check with the appropriate consulate to ensure you have the proper documentation. Always check your passport and visa requirements. The Reservations Center cannot assume responsibility for passengers not having correct documentation.

### TAXES & FEES

Each guest must pay a \$95 US port fee (includes cruising tax and park fee) at the end of the charter when settling your bill. These may be paid by Visa, MC, AMEX, cash or Travelers Checks. A departure tax of \$35 US per person will be collected at the airport when departing (cash).

### C-CARDS

Please bring your c-card or proof of certification. The divemaster requires proof of certification before the first dive.

### HEALTH

We have a complete first aid kit on board, including oxygen. You may want to bring motion sickness medicine if you feel you'll need it. We recommend a complete physical prior to your trip. There is no smoking allowed inside the yacht or on the dive deck. Smoking is only permitted on the sun deck.

### PACKING

When packing, please watch the weight and size of your bags. You will need to check with the airline for more information on weight restrictions. For easy luggage storage, we recommend you pack a soft duffel bag.

## **CLOTHING**

T-shirts and shorts are the usual attire due to the warm and sunny days. Evenings can be cool. Therefore, you should pack a sweatshirt or windbreaker. Tennis shoes are recommended for land tours. For easy luggage storage, we recommend you pack a soft duffel bag

## **ENTERTAINMENT**

There is a variety of nightly entertainment including night diving, fish identification slide shows, games and more. The crew especially enjoys recent DVD movies, musical CD's, magazines, and books. Feel free to bring along your favorites.

## **DIVE GEAR SUGGESTIONS**

We suggest you pack the following: mask, fins, snorkel, regulator with pressure gauge, buoyancy compensator, depth, gauge, dive computer, wetsuit, dive light, and batteries. We encourage and recommend you have your equipment checked before arrival. Each piece of gear should be marked with waterproof paint or tape.
